Pastor's Corner

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As you may have heard, our beloved United Methodist Church is going through a very difficult time in its history over issues related to human sexuality. It is not the first time our denomination has faced controversy in our long, long existence, and it probably will not be the last, However, being in the midst of controversy with fellow Christians, no matter what the issue, never feels very good. This current period of discomfort is no exception.

I think one of the biggest problems we face as a local church caught up in the denominational turmoil, is the confusion that seems to swirl around us from all directions. Although we are strong in our own faith and convictions, it is difficult to know which things we hear from the outside are true, which things are false, and which things hover somewhere in the middle. It can be easy to be swept away in the emotion of hyperbolic assertions from both sides of the issues, and we can lose our true north. In other words, we can lose sight of what it means to be disciples of Jesus Christ in service to our neighbors and our God. We can easily forget our responsibility to be the hands and feet of Jesus Christ in the world.

In an effort to help us wade through the issues together, Pastor Bill Graham and I would like to invite you all to an open meeting in Goodell Hall on Tuesday, May 16, 2023, at 7:00 PM. We would like to present to you a balanced overview of the history of the current controversy over human sexuality. We will present the main issues in question. These issues include whether self-avowed, practicing homosexuals should be ordained and whether United Methodist pastors should be able to officiate same-gender marriages. We will explore the history of what the Book of Discipline of the United Methodist Church currently states about human sexuality. We will take a look at both the traditional and progressive positions on these issues. Finally, we will discuss where the United Methodist Church finds itself after the Special General Conference of 2019, and where we stand as we approach General Conference of 2024. Though Bill and I will be making the presentation, our District Superintendent, Edgar Brady, will be in attendance to answer any questions that we cannot.

My hope is that this meeting will help to alleviate any anxieties we are carrying in our hearts relating to the UMC's future. None of us has a crystal ball or knows for certain what lies ahead. But knowing the facts, can be a comfort and can help us to remain calm and keep things in perspective. Finally, I ask you all to pray for the Church and its leaders, for the world, and for one another as we travel together through this difficult and upsetting time. Never forget that I love you all.
