Pastor's Corner

Thank you for the welcome you have given me as your new pastor! I am grateful for your kindness. Many of you have told me that you are happy that I'm now pastor of Portage Faith United Methodist Church. I appreciate the confidence and trust you've expressed in me. In June I was a member of the congregation. In July I became your pastor. The change was sudden and a surprise to me as well as to you. I'm trying to figure out what that change means. We already shared a relationship, now the relationship has changed. When we come to church on Sunday mornings, we generally think of ourselves as the ones who do the welcoming. We stand at the door and greet people. We do our best to be friendly and make everyone feel comfortable. We check-in with each other. We have the responsibility and the ability to welcome others on Sunday morning. Jesus tells us that we need to remember how we received welcome ourselves before we can genuinely welcome others. When Jesus sends his disciples out on their first mission, he sends them out dependent on the hospitality of the people they meet. "Don't take anything with you," Jesus says. "Travel light. I want you to rely on the welcome you receive along the way as you share the good news." Jesus sends out his disciples lacking the physical essentials necessary to support their lives. "I want you to experience what it means to be dependent on others for a cup of water, a square meal, a roof over your heads." In order to take care of others we need to know what it feels like to be vulnerable ourselves. We need to experience how God meets our needs when we are vulnerable through the welcome of others.

I've shared with many of you that the highlight of our trip to Ireland this past June was reconnecting relatives. I felt pretty nervous driving up those narrow lanes in Ireland to see relatives we had not seen or contacted for fifty years. How was this going to go? How would we be received? How would they respond to us? Afterall we were bursting into the daily routine of our relatives. What we discovered was that our relatives were ready for us. Their front doors were open and multiple generations were gathered inside each house. Before we could get to the door, they were outside on the driveway embracing us with warm hugs. Even the shy ones came outside to greet us. They took us into their homes. It wasn't very long before they were serving us tea and scones, or even a meal around the table. Before we knew it, we were all swapping family stories and sharing what was important in our lives. Our Irish relatives gave us more than enough to eat and kept encouraging us to eat more. They showed us their farms, pointed out family landmarks, and drove us to see their churches. It was a "drop everything," attentive hospitality that we received and it humbled us. At some point in each visit, it began to feel like a holy moment. We were definitely on the receiving end of extravagant hospitality.

I invite us all to think "back" and recall "what" or "who" first made us feel welcome at Portage Faith Church. What made us want to stay here? What made us want to return Sunday after Sunday. What made us want to participate in the life of Portage Faith Church? This is a time of new beginning for all of us. It's good to remember Jesus's words. Jesus said, "Whoever welcomes you welcomes me and whoever welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me". Pastor Bill


