An update and some clarity on the <u>United Methodist Men's Utility Fund.</u> On May 8, 2016, the United Methodist Men started a Utility Fund. A number of men in the group voted to start a Utility Fund for the church's water source. At each breakfast meeting, two collection baskets were passed: one for the cost of the breakfast and one for the Utility Fund with donations of \$2 here and \$5 there. The fund grew to approximately \$10,000 and the men decided to invest \$9,000 into a certificate of deposit to earn interest. After the CD matured and having earned \$423.31 interest, the money was transferred to the churches Money Market Account and earmarked as the United Methodist Men's Utility Fund. The men's group are continuing to collect donations and look forward to the day the church's water issues are solved. The United Methodist Men's Utility Fund has a current balance of \$3,514.31 (plus \$9,423.31 earmarked in church's money market fund).

Just create your personal, secure account. You'll have the ability to give with a credit/debit card, an electronic check. The fee for using an electronic check is only .25 cents each. The fee for using a non-American Express credit card is 2.2% plus .30 cents each transaction. American Express is 3.5% plus .30 cents. The preferred and economical way to give is using your bank's electronic check. You will need your bank's routing number and account number to create this online giving option.
